The Friends of Arvada Fire Protection District (FAFPD) is a relatively new 501c3 non-profit but we have already raised enough money to make our first purchase. In October, we bought two AC Hotsticks. One will be placed in the Battalion Chief's car and one with the on-duty Safety Officer. The Hotsticks will allow use to determine if downed power lines are energized or not. If we can determine if there is no hazard in getting too close to the lines, we can move them out of traffic quickly and re-open a road that has been adversely affected by these downed lines.

In the past, we had to assume that all downed lines were energized and we closed down the road to all traffic until the power company showed up to confirm that the lines were safe to move.


